Existing station passageway

Minervapassage

Roof existing passageway

This passageway will be much wider. The old roof has been removed, the new one built and moved into position.

New station passageway

Brittenpassage

Sheet piles

Large amounts of sheet piles and foundation piles are going into the ground. This is to enable construction of the two station passageways.

Raising the height of the metro

The Minervapassage will become a lot wider and taller. The height of the two middle metro tracks has already been raised.

Parnassusweg

Here, we are working on the viaduct and the technical room for metro traffic. This will result in diversions.

Platform widening

By moving track 4, we are widening railway platform 3-4. This will give you more space on the platform.

Roof sections new passageway

Three gigantic roof sections have already been built and are in position. You will be walking under these in a few years' time.

Platform widening

Because the railway platforms are too crowded, we are widening this platform. This will give you more space to move around.

Work sites

We created five work sites: south of the station, between the tracks and north of the station.

Roof sections under the A10

We build two roof sections, remove track and A10 and slide them into place. Two additional tracks will be built here for international train traffic.

Digging the Brittenpassage

Once the roof sections are in place, the excavation of the new station passage can begin.

Repositioning the A10 Zuid

We are adding a slight bend to the motorway to enable us to widen the crowded railway platform. This will necessitate a slightly lower speed limit.

Until 2024

Since 2018, work has been under way outdoors to extend the station. Much of this work is happening underground or behind construction hoardings. The most important work during this period involves building the roof for the new station passageway on work sites and putting the roof sections into position on the foundations that are already in place.
